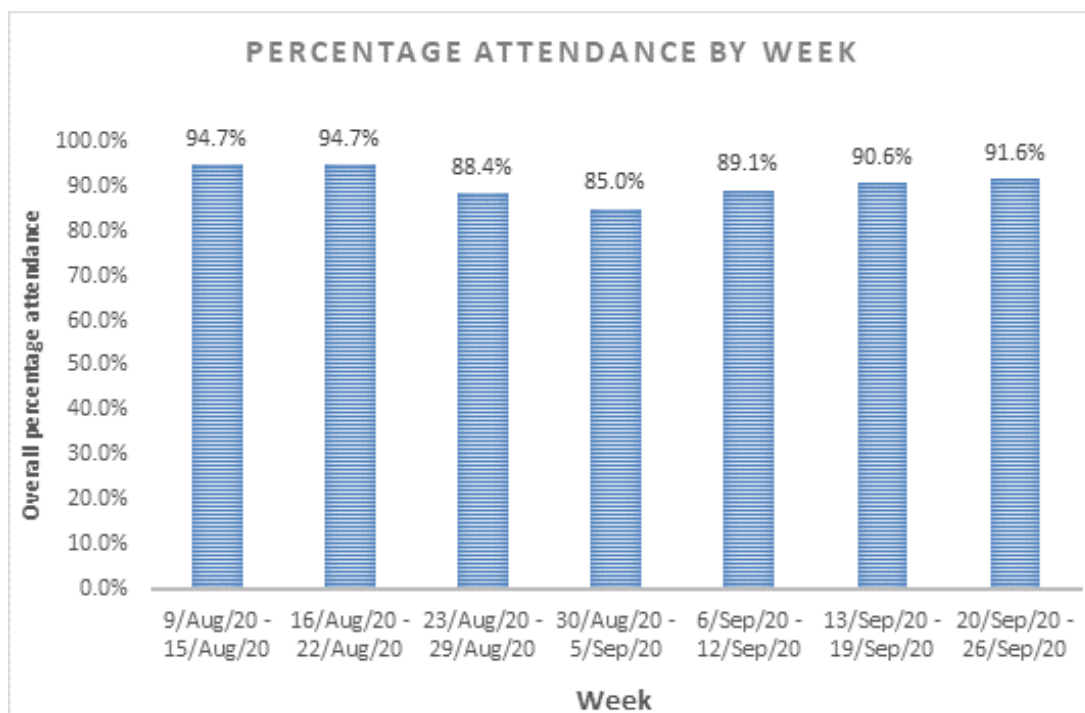

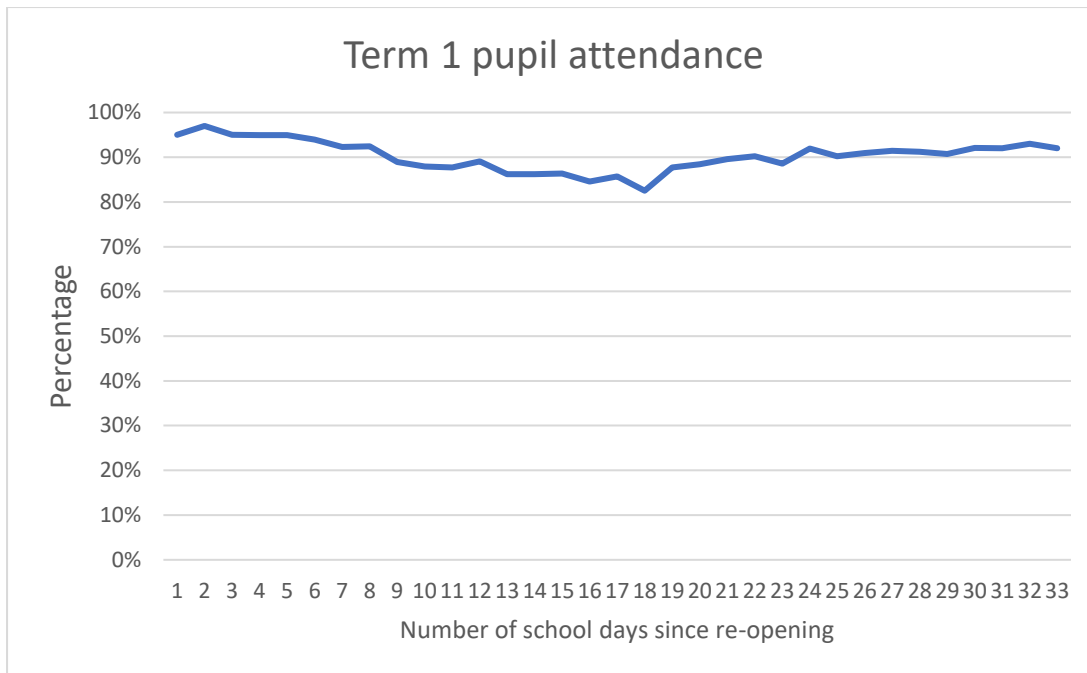

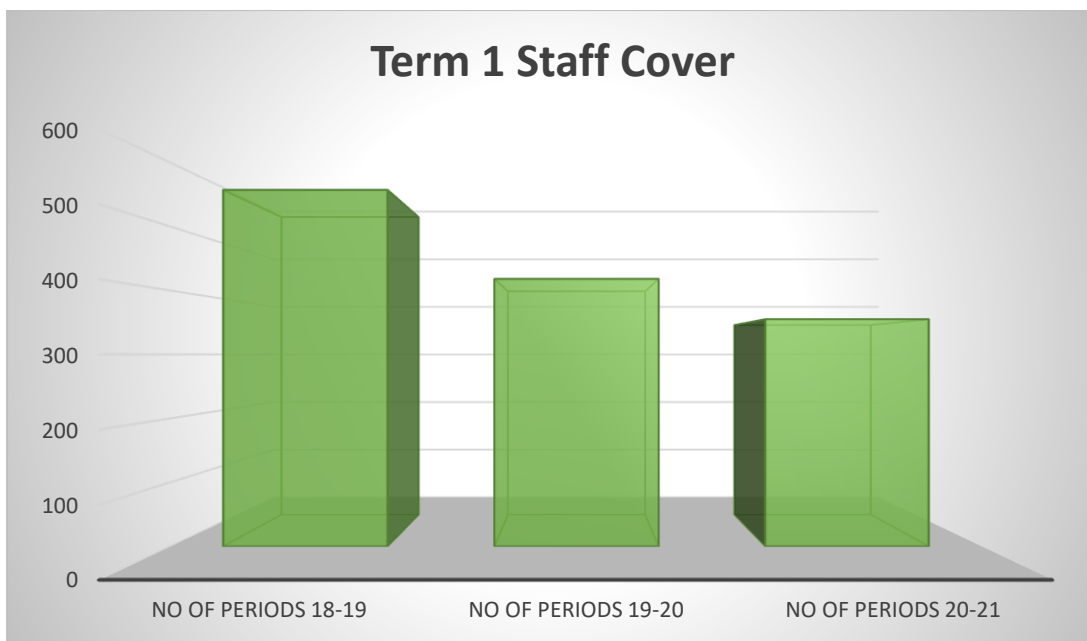
### Term 1 Pupil attendance (weekly)

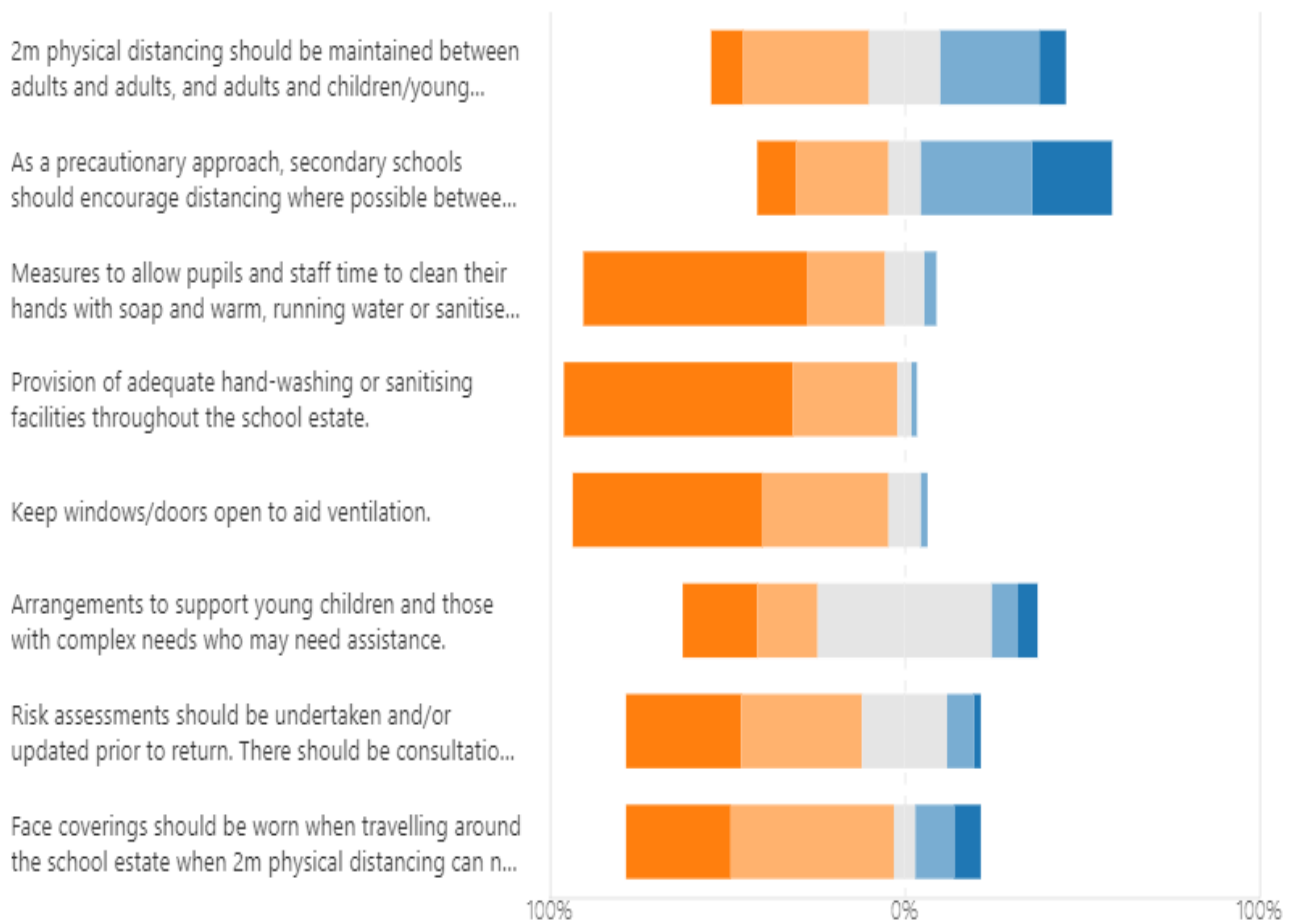

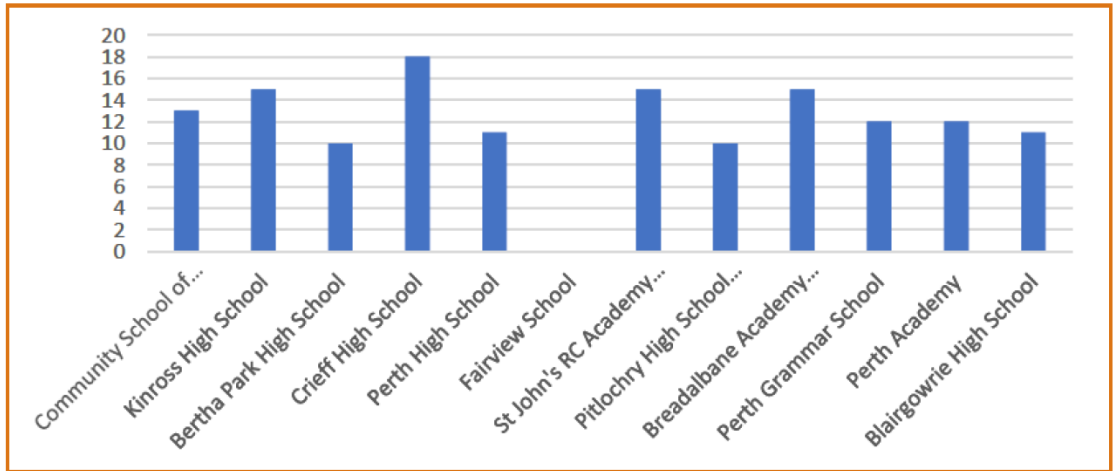
**As a precautionary approach, secondary schools should encourage distancing where possible between S5/S6 pupils**

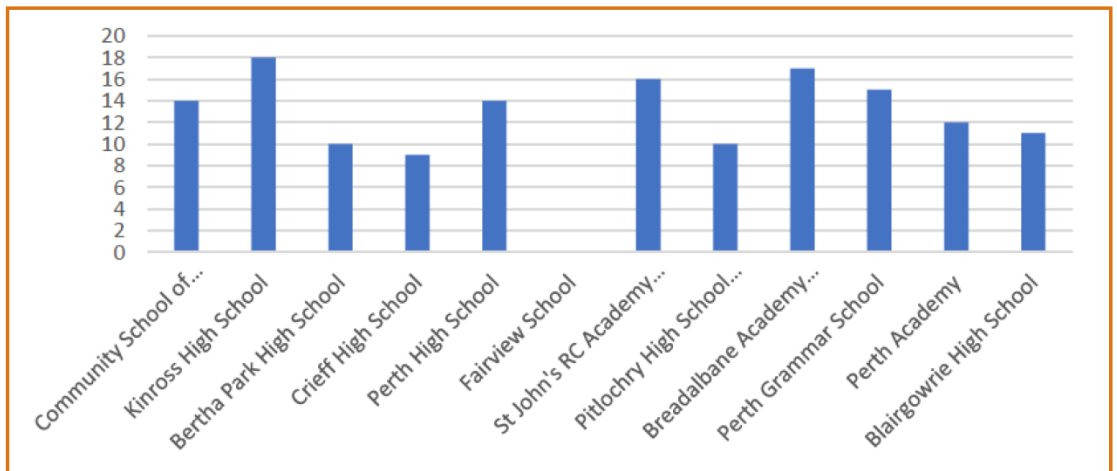
