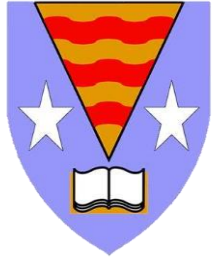

College Application Process



- Applications are done online directly through the college.
 - Young people can apply to as many colleges and as many courses as they wish
- Most colleges follow a similar process of:
 - Online application, including a personal statement
 - 1-to-1 or group interview
- If young people have additional support needs, colleges have transition officers and we will support this in school

Application Process



Application Decisions



- **Conditional Offer**

- There are qualifications or experiences the young person will need to complete or provide.

- **Unconditional Offer**

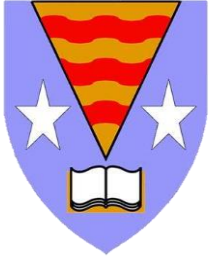
- The young person already has the required qualifications and experience when submitting their application

- **Unsuccessful Application**

- **Reserve Place**

- When a course becomes oversubscribed the young person may be offered a place on the reserve list.

Funding



- Funding is provided by the Student Award Agency Scotland (SAAS).
- Most full-time NC/NQ/Higher students, will have their fees paid direct to the College by the Scottish Funding Council (SFC)

Accommodation



- **Student accommodation**

- Provided by the university for a fee, usually from September to June.

- **Private Accommodation**

- Offered by the private sector, where students access letting opportunities available to the general public.

- **Remain at home**

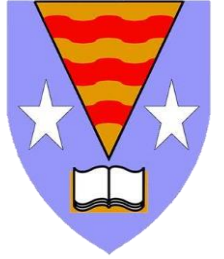
- Providing it is feasible to do so, students may remain in their current situation and travel to/from college each day.

Apprenticeships



- **Graduate apprenticeships**
 - You will work for your employer, get paid, and achieve a degree once the apprenticeship is complete.
- **Modern Apprenticeships**
 - Gain hands-on experience while earning a wage and studying towards an industry-relevant qualification
- **Foundation Apprenticeships**
 - Taken over two years, typically beginning in S5, pupils take time out from classes to gain workplace experience alongside their N5/Highers.

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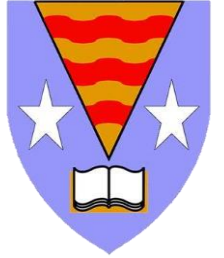

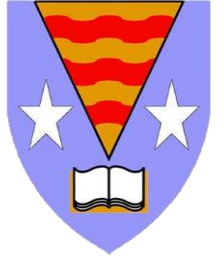
