Mrs Telford is also coordinating a programme of learning for young people who have no SQA examinations or 1 examination.

Study leave (Teacher availability)

Young people with 2 or more examinations are permitted 20 days of study leave over the 6 week long SQA examination diet.

Where possible, your teachers will not be allocated cover classes on the teaching day before your SQA examination but will still be required to teach their timetabled S1 – S3 classes.

In addition, where possible, your teachers will not be allocated cover classes when you are currently timetabled for double periods.

Your personalised exam arrangements

You will receive a personalised exam timetable

- Check subject and level
- Check exam dates, start and finish times
- Check the venue of your exams
- Check additional arrangements
- Check the postal address on your exam timetable

Exam Day

- Know where you are going – exam location
- Check your seat number – notice boards outside the assembly hall
- Be 10 minutes early
- The exam time stated in the timetable is when the exam starts



Exam Day

- You must sit in your assigned seat
- Be prepared and bring all of the equipment you require (including a calculator if the exam allows this)
- Wear school uniform



Exam Day

You cannot take the following into the exam:

- Bags / coats – please use your locker
- Books / Notes
- Pencil cases
- Fizzy juice or food – only water in a clear bottle
- Electronic devices – phone, tablet, smart watches etc.



During the exam

- Listen to invigilators instructions
- Write your name, centre name and Scottish Candidate Number (SCN) on your exam paper
- SCN cards will be on your allocated exam desk in the exam room



During the exam

- Read questions / instructions fully
- Plan your time properly
- Answer all questions as fully as possible
- Focus on your own work



During the exam

- Do not talk, distract others or cause disturbance
- No toilet breaks
- Check over your work before the end of the exam



What if on exam day?

- I am running late?
- I am ill and cannot attend my exam?
- I forget something to write with?
- The exam is interrupted?
- I finish my exam ahead of time?

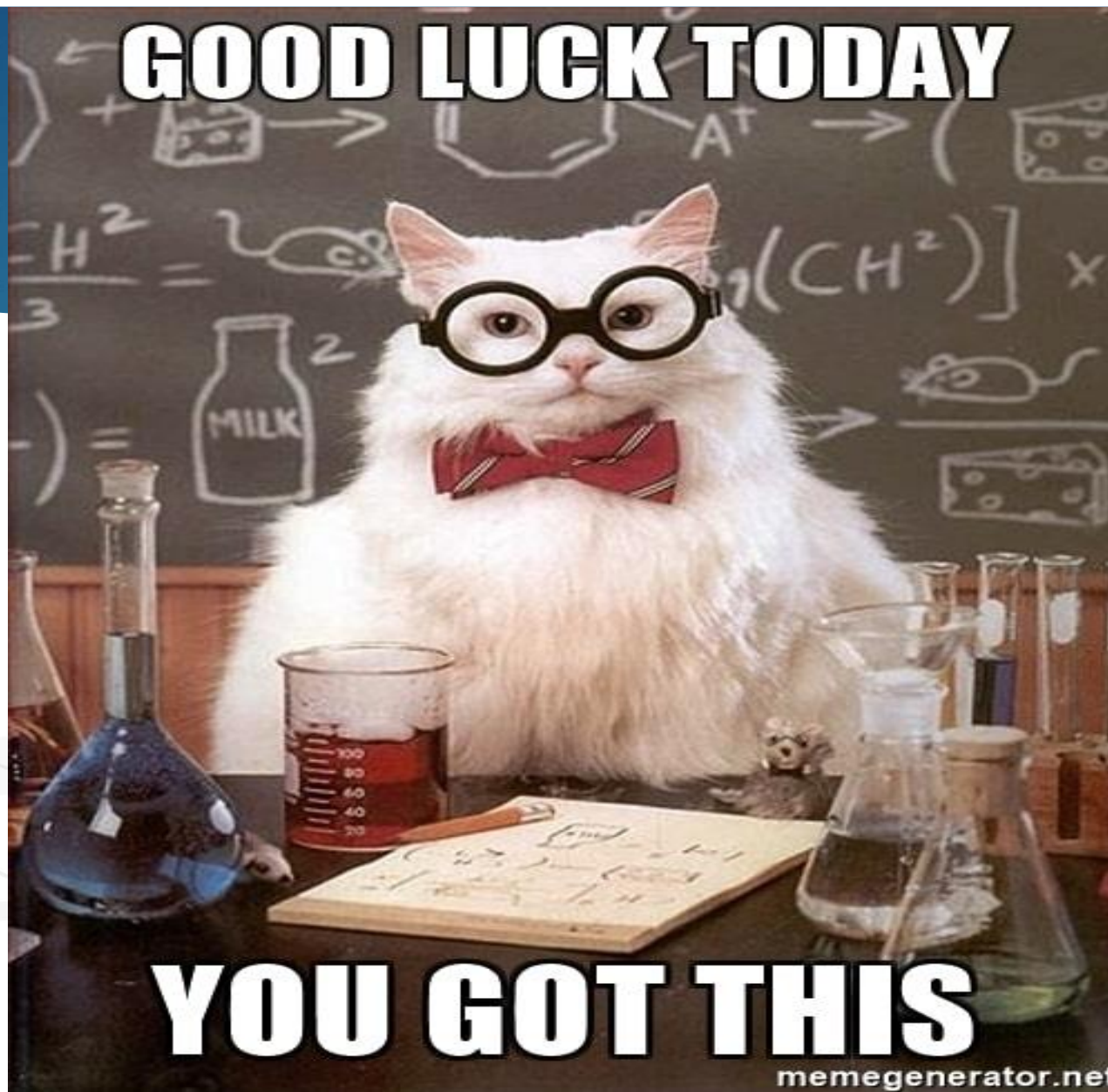
