Interval and Lunchtime

The Café Zone is open at interval, and lunchtime. Food in the Café Zone is provided by Tayside Contracts.

You should queue up, collect your food and then pay for it before finding a seat to sit at. Alternatively, you can “pre-order” your food using the Fusion App which will be available to collect at lunchtime.

Crieff High School is a cashless school therefore school lunches are purchased using ParentPay. Information about ParentPay and the Fusion App will be emailed home.
