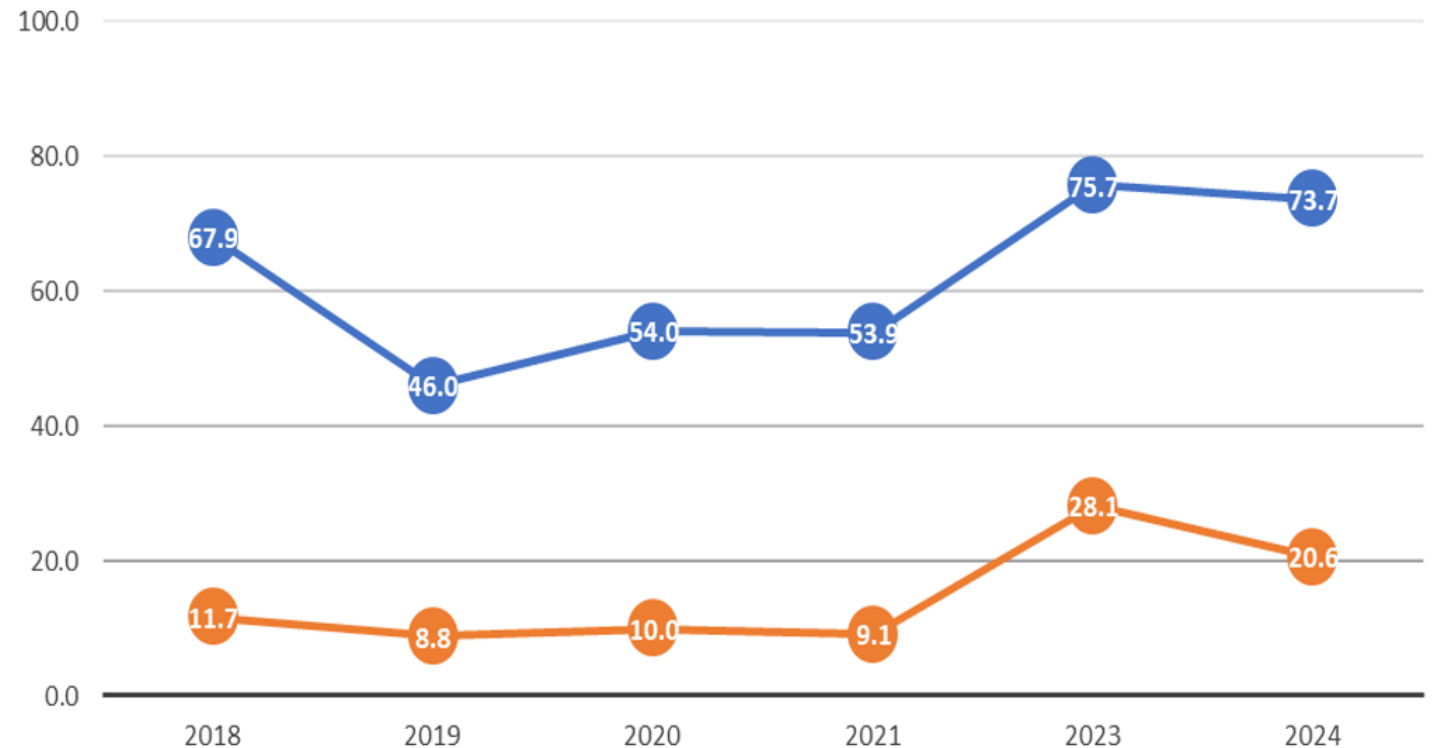


Living our school values

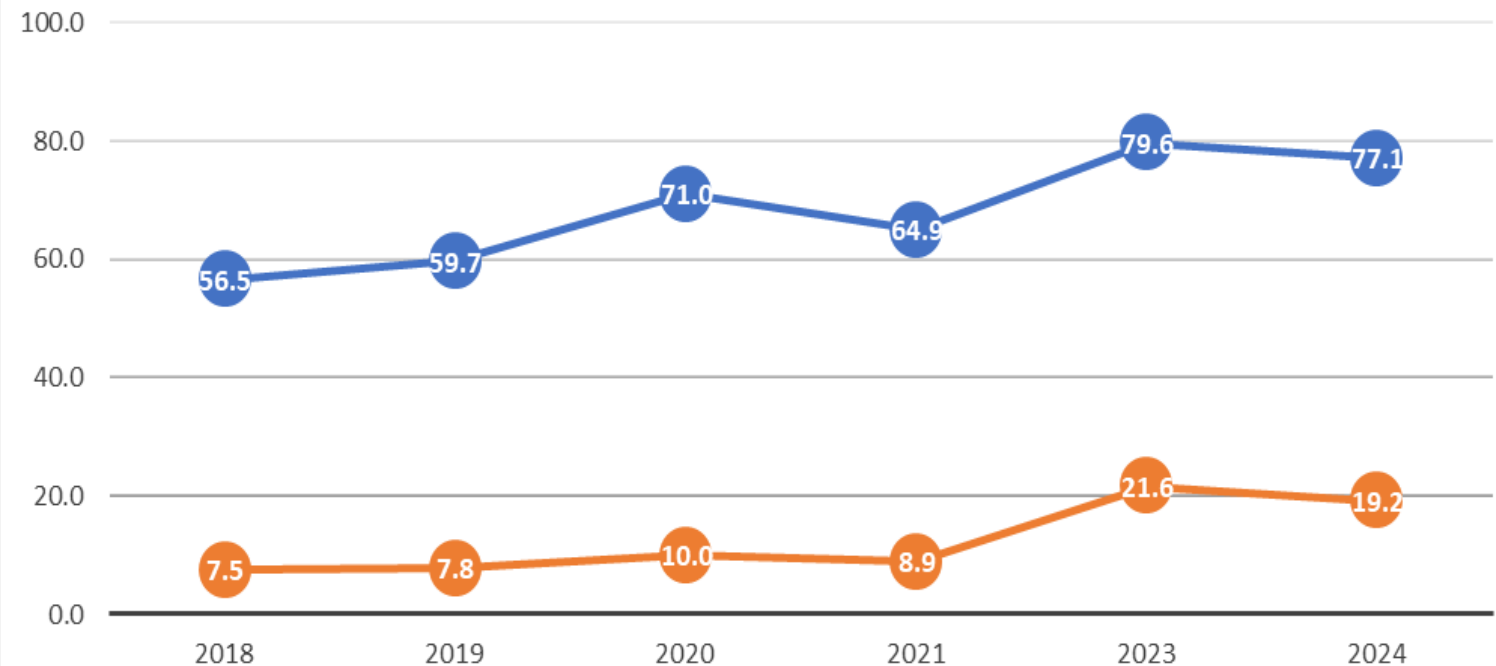


Living our school values

5. Other young people treat me fairly and with respect.



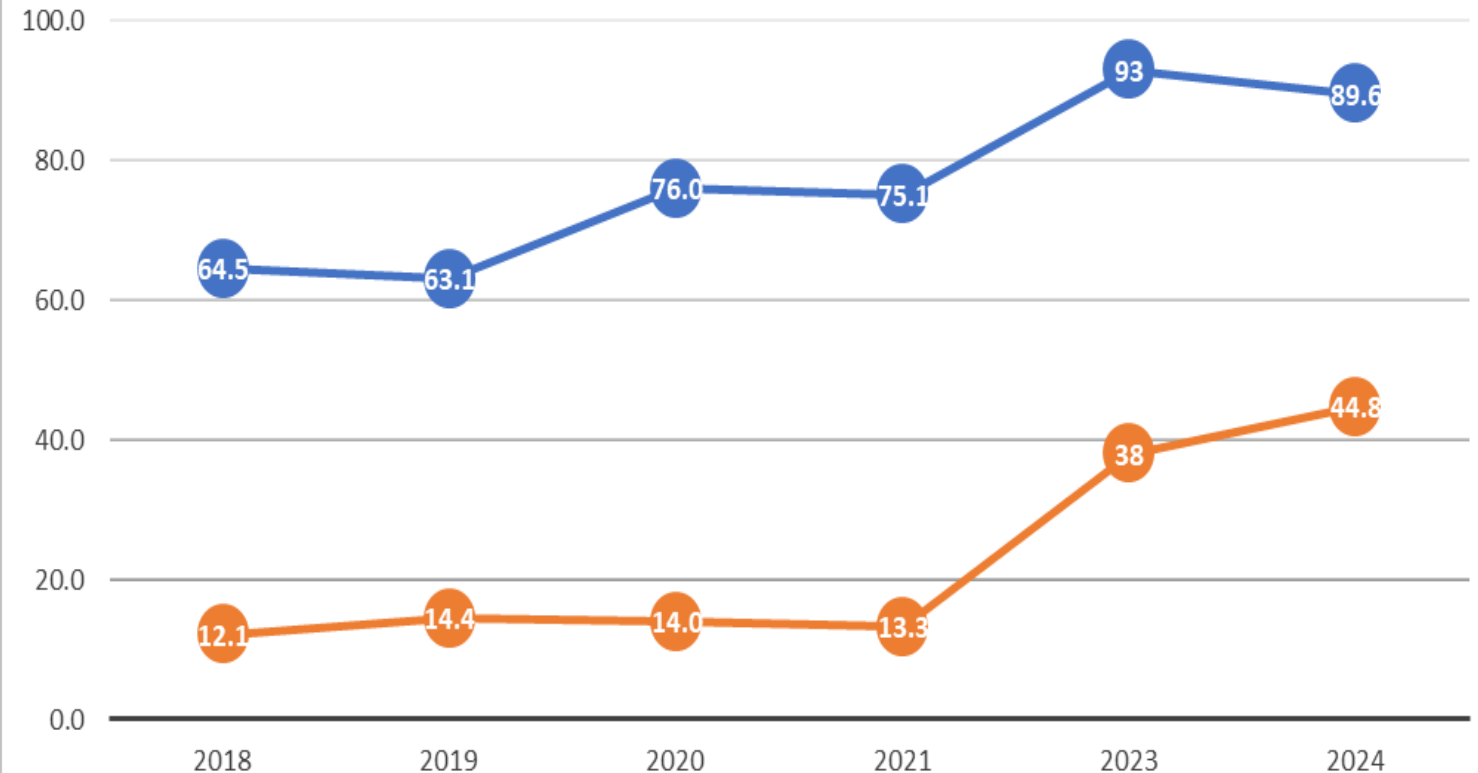


Living our school values

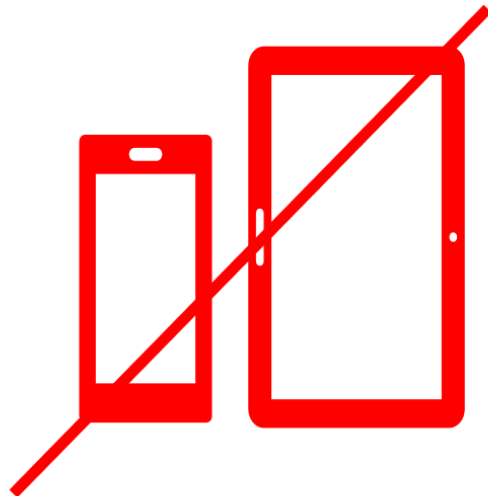

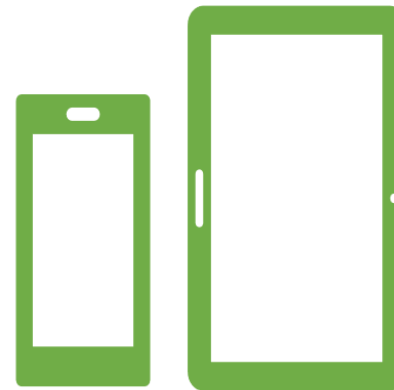


Mobile Devices - In classes

Positive mental health of our young people

Mobile phone discussion, consultation and decision to be made for August 2024:

- UNESCO 2023 Technology in education? Report – “proximity to a mobile device was found to distract students (for up to 20 mins) and to have a negative impact on learning”
- PISA report – “students get distracted by using digital devices”
- Scottish government guidance in the coming weeks – poorer behaviour and internal truancy
- Constantly in demand through notifications
- Peer issues identified through group chats / Safeguarding concerns
- Tension between our CHS Priority One and CHS Priority Two
- Conflicting views of teachers and parents / carers





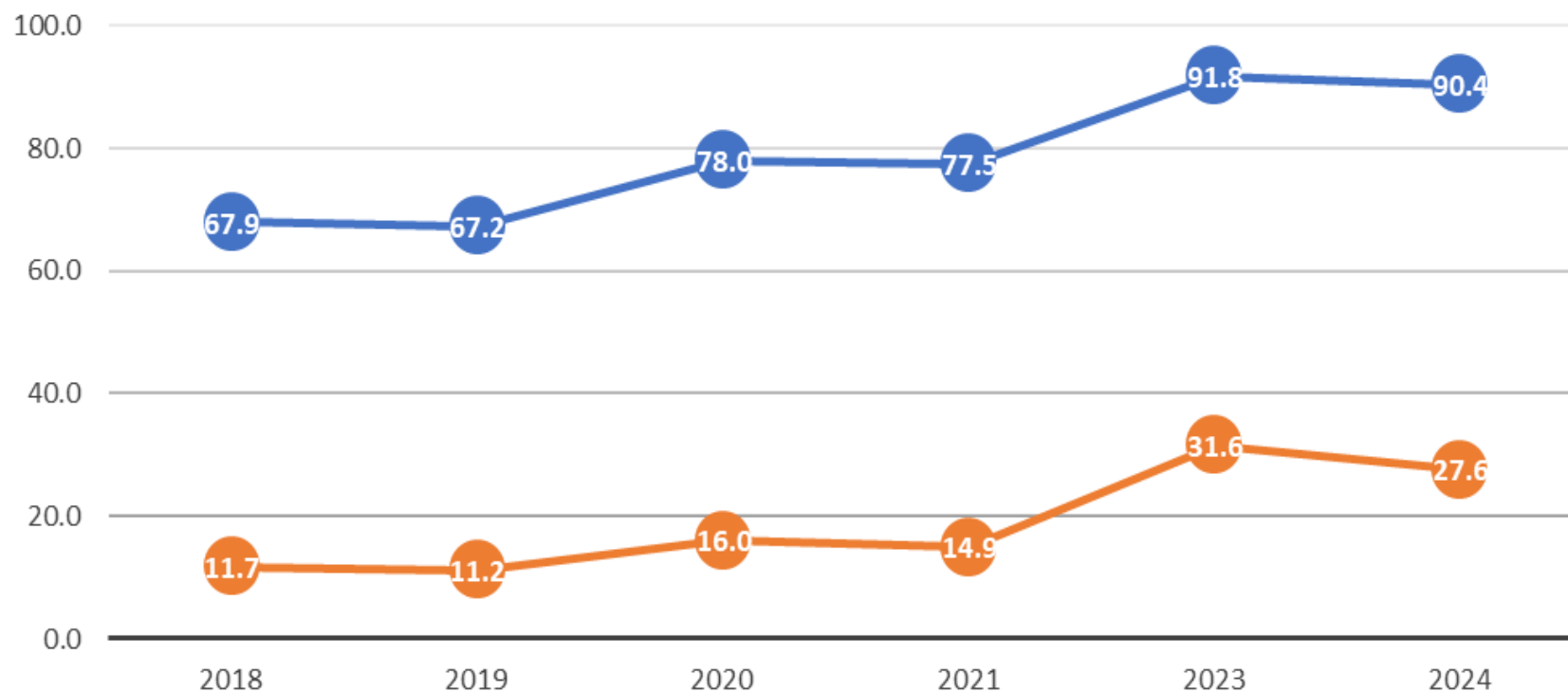

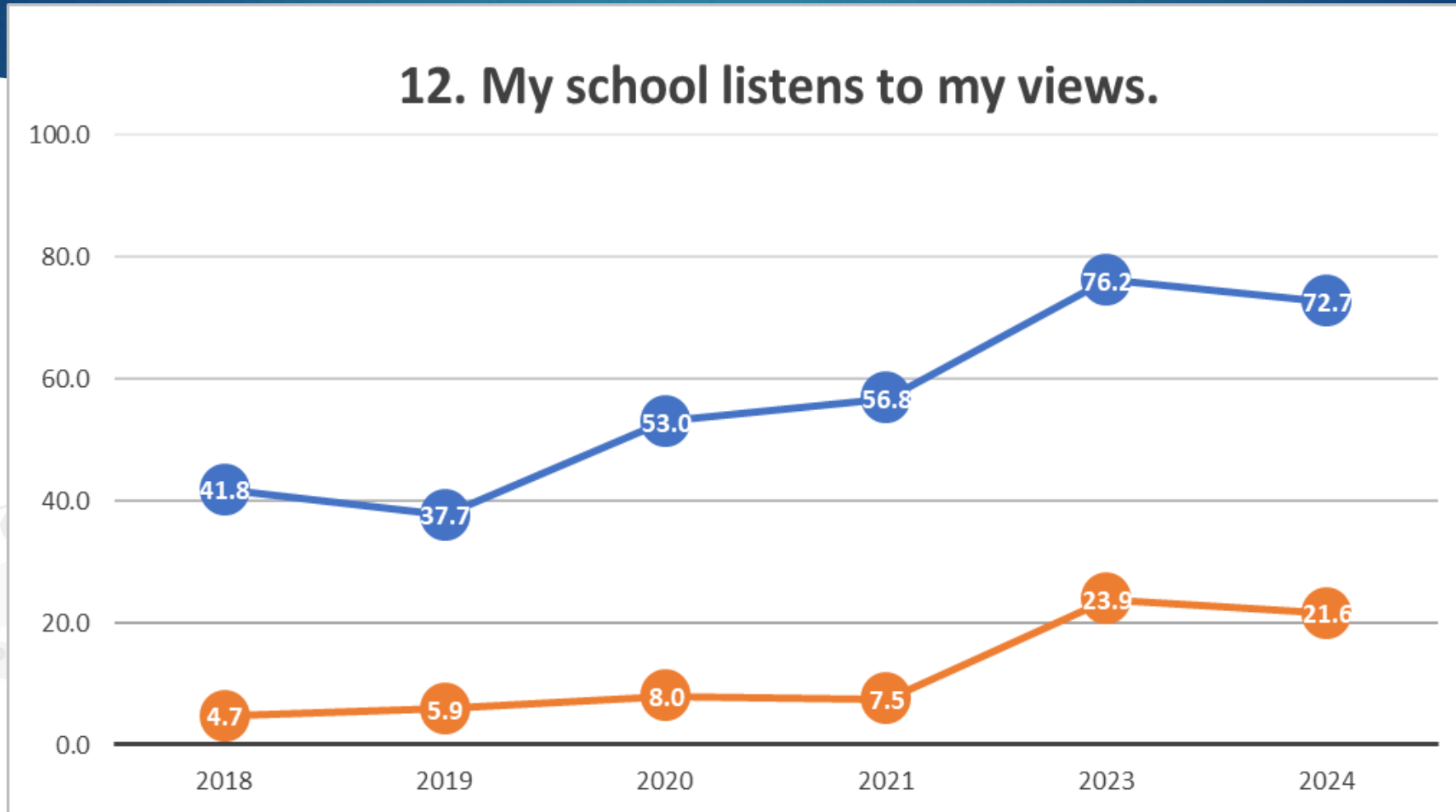

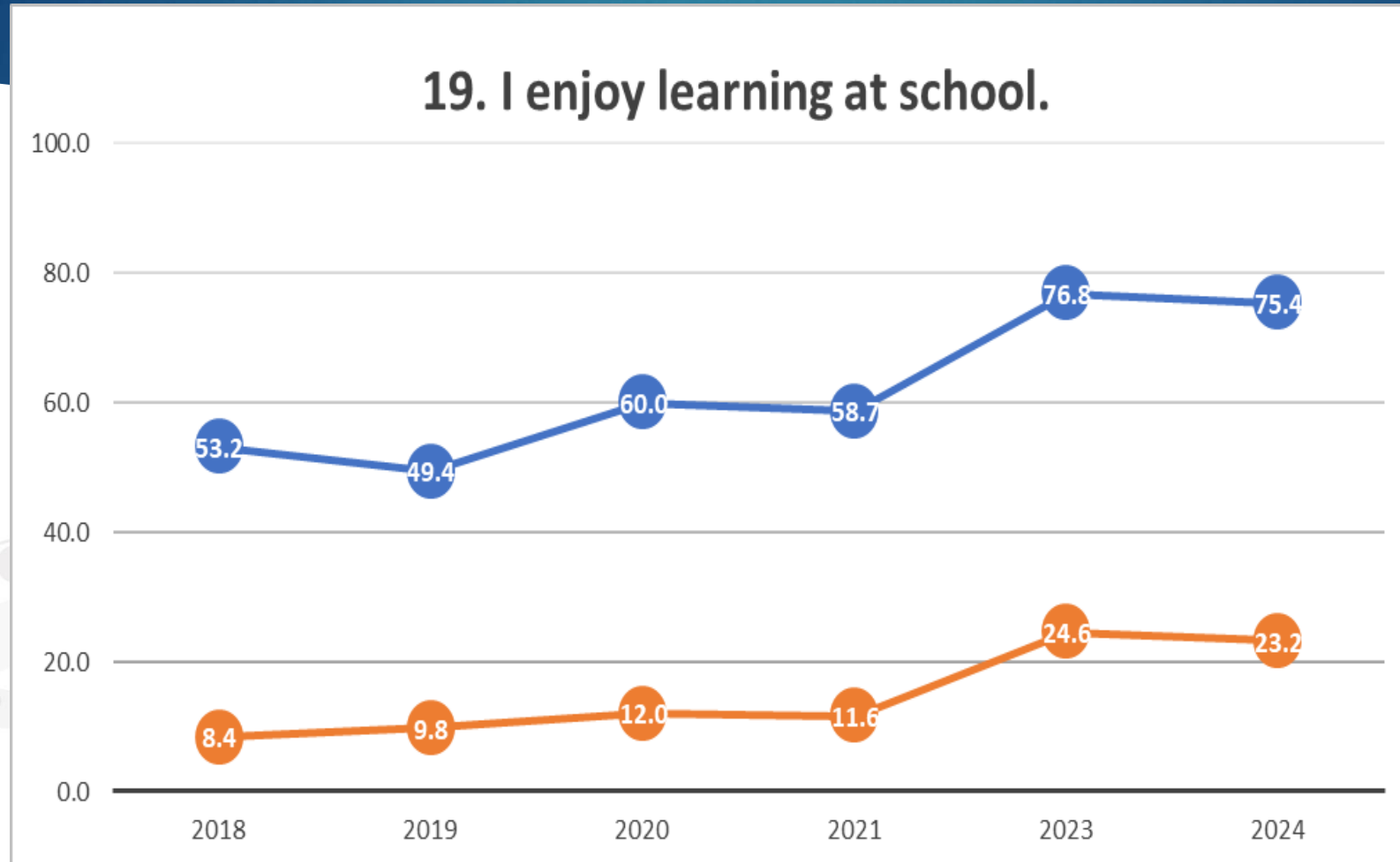
12. My school listens to my views.

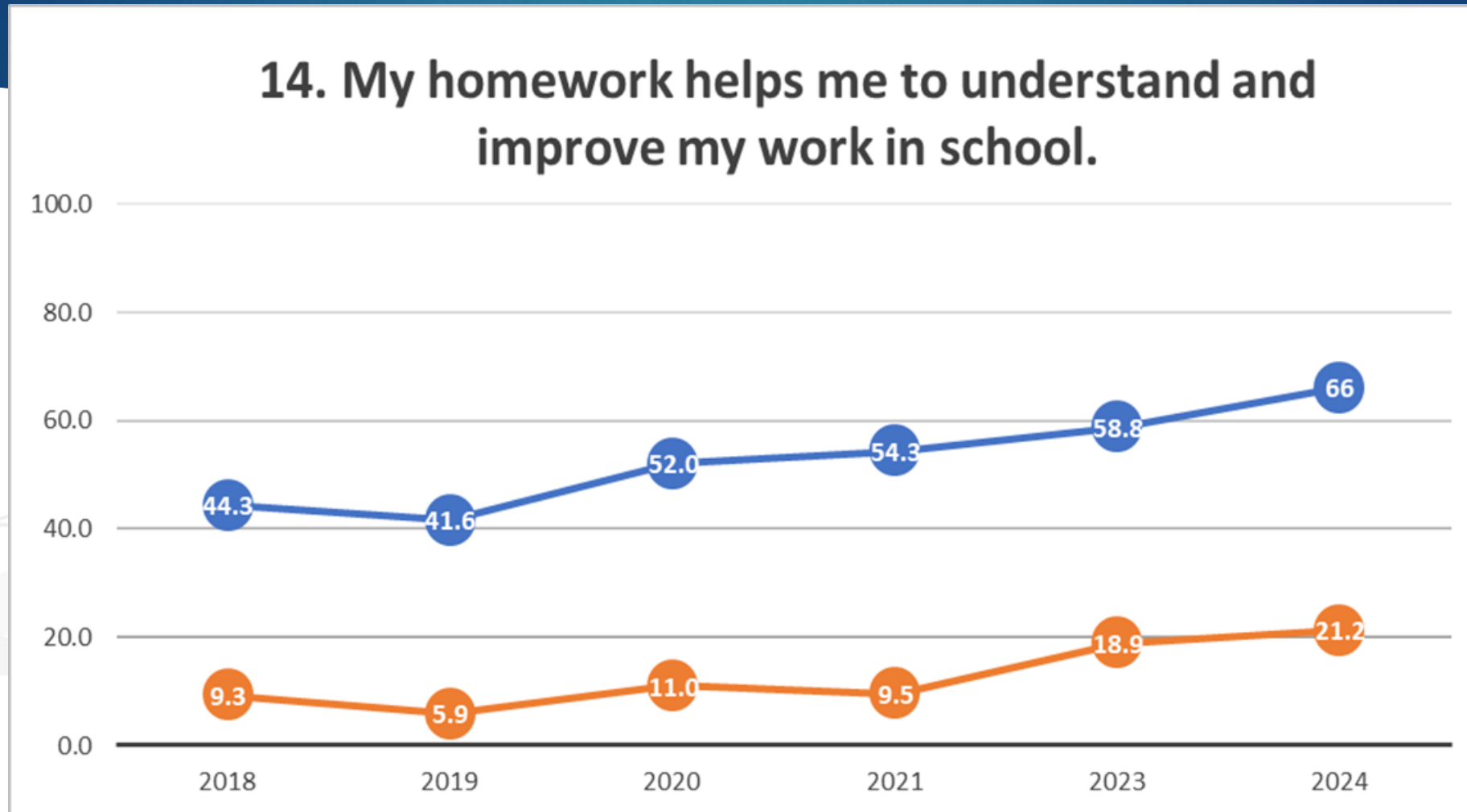
19. I enjoy learning at school.

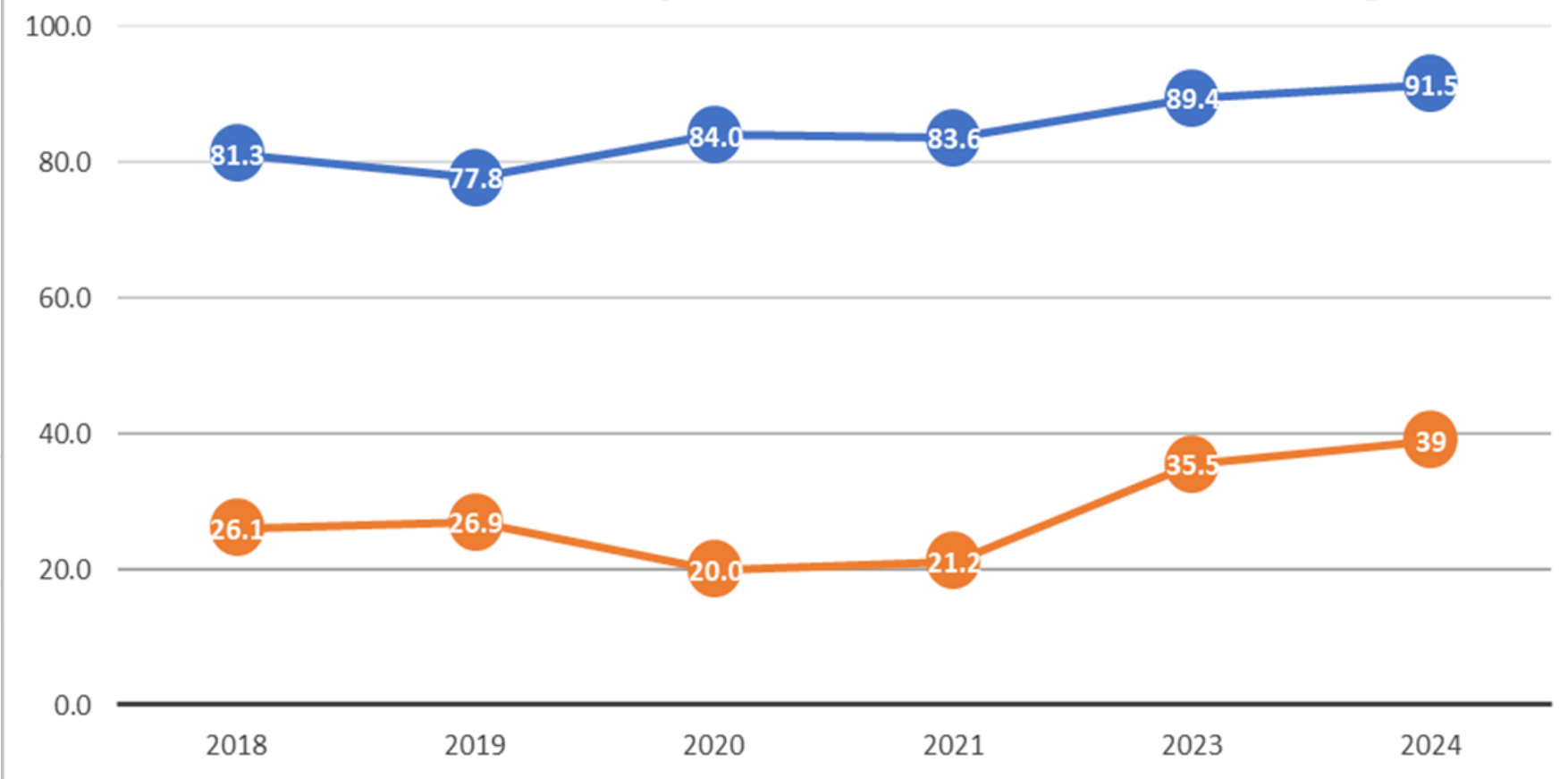
14. My homework helps me to understand and improve my work in school.
